

Firebird Handprint Activity

Supplies

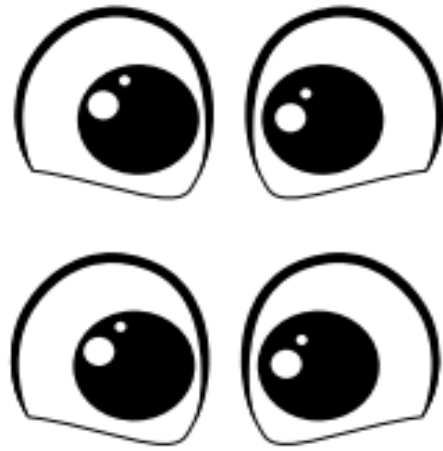
- Colored cardstock or construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Pencil
- Firebird template (below)

Directions

1. Using the template, print and cut out the pieces you need.
2. Begin to create the firebird by gluing the eyes to the middle of the head.
3. Glue the beak in between and slightly overlapping the eyes.
4. Place the feet on the bottom of firebird and glue in place.
5. Cut out 3 long, thin rectangles and glue to the top, back of the firebird's head.
6. Trace your hand onto the red, orange, and yellow paper once per color. Cut out the handprints.
7. Fan the handprints out along the backside of the firebird and glue in place.



Please note the colors in the example differ from yours as this was adapted from a peacock activity.

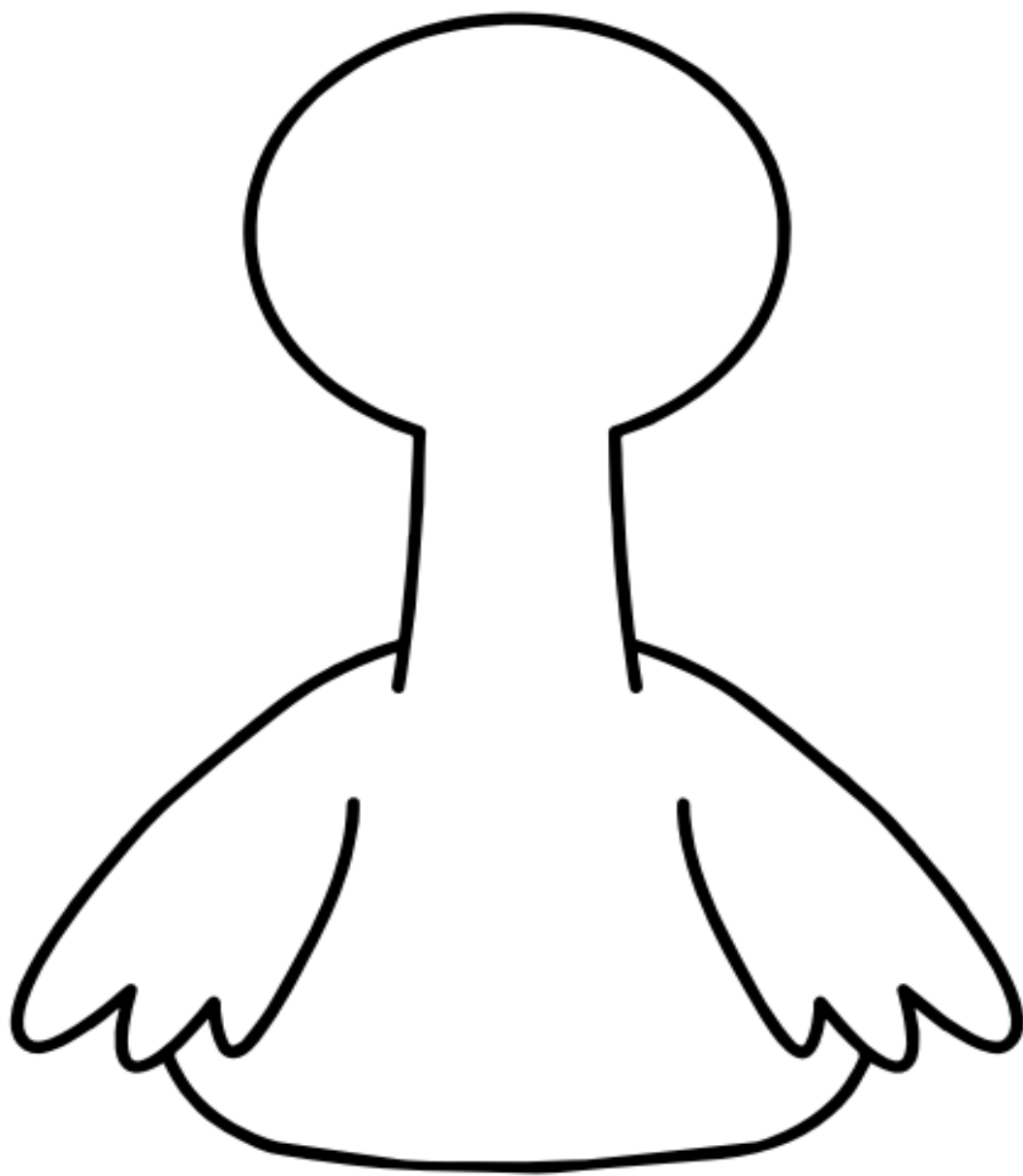

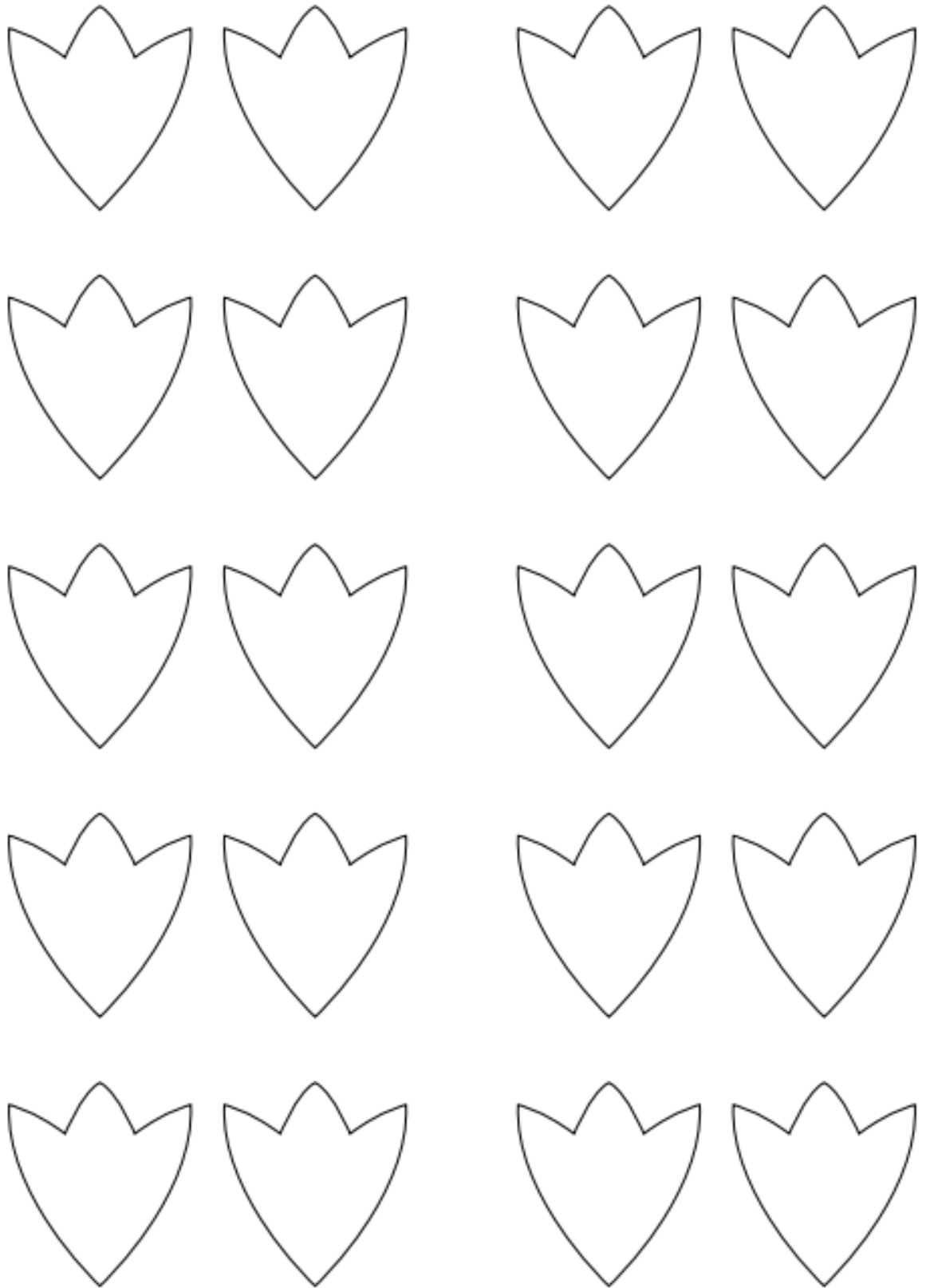
feet

print on white paper

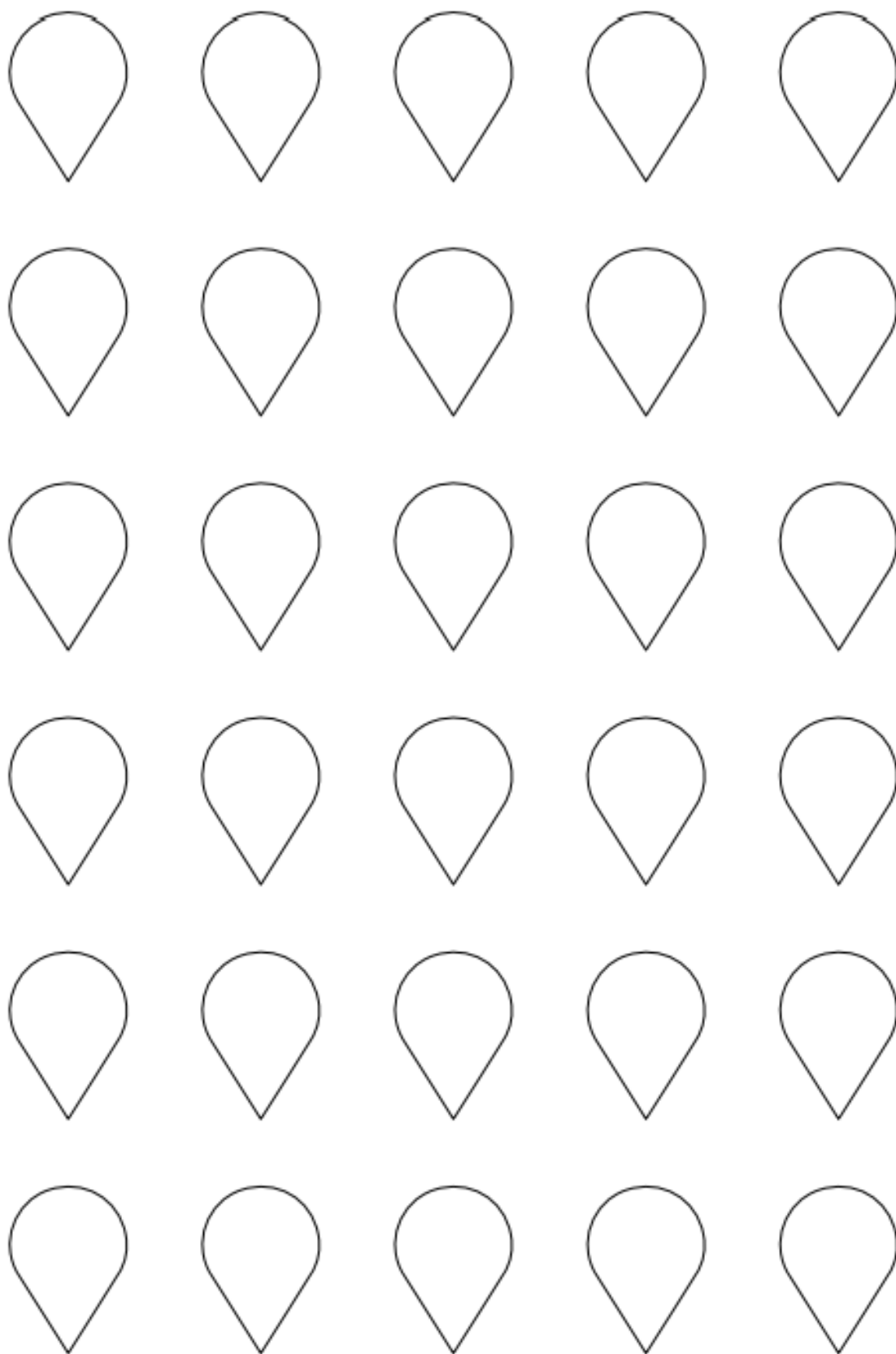

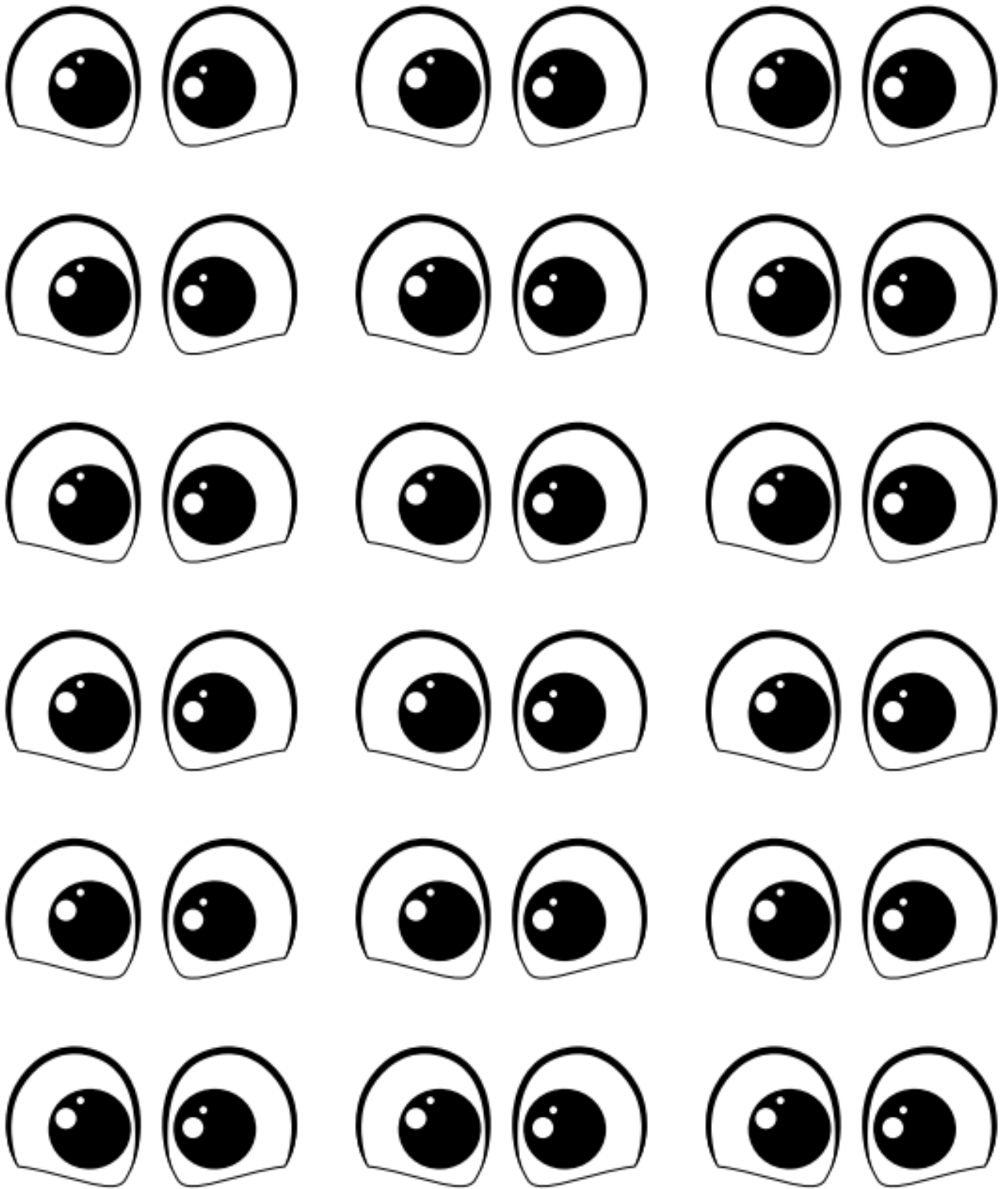
