Firebird Handprint Activity

Supplies


- Colored cardstock or construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Pencil
- Firebird template (below)

Directions

- 1. Using the template, print and cut out the pieces you need.
- 2. Begin to create the firebird by gluing the eyes to the middle of the head.
- 3. Glue the beak in between and slightly overlapping the eyes.
- 4. Place the feet on the bottom of firebird and glue in place.
- 5. Cut out 3 long, thin rectangles and glue to the top, back of the firebird's head.
- 6. Trace your hand onto the red, orange, and yellow paper once per color. Cut out the handprints.
- 7. Fan the handprints out along the backside of the firebird and glue in place.



Please note the colors in the example differ from yours as this was adapted from a peacock activity.


